#### Approval of the Annual Return Minute No 3

The Annual Governance Statement, Section 1 of the Annual Return for the year ended  $31^{st}$  March 2017 was approved by the council and signed by the chairman and clerk.

# Beck Burn Windfarm Community Fund Minute No 4

Cllr GR gave a breakdown of grants approved by the Hallburn Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund Panel, at their meeting on the 6<sup>th</sup> June. Arthuret Parish Councils bid for £4,000 Phase 1 of The Border Reivers Heritage Project to be developed in the Council rooms was approved.

A total of £63,802 was allocated to projects with the remaining £20,000 to go forward to the next meeting in December for future grant applications. The Education and Training budget allocated £8,500 with £22,000 remaining.

It was agreed to consider submission in December to the panel for funding to extend the footpath along the riverside on Dollies Brae. Estimates for work to be sought.

#### Beck Burn small grants fund Minute No 5

The allocation of £5,000 a year to the parish council for community groups to access was discussed. A number of local groups and organisations had applied for funding or expressed an interest in receiving a grant.

Following consideration the following grants were proposed. **Longtown W.I.** £350 towards a dinner to mark the  $90^{th}$  year of the founding of Longtown W.I. and promote membership. **Bowling Club** Requested £500 agreed £250 towards the purchase of an aerator.

It was also agreed the parish council apply for a grant to replace the oak tree that has died at the Bobbin Mill Garden.
