County Cllr VT reported

- Has contacted Peter McCall, Police Commissioner, raising concerns of anti-social behaviour in Longtown. Agreed the clerk write to the Chief Constable voicing the councils disappointing response by the police regarding the vandalism at the Lochinvar play area.
- Working with newsagent proprietor looking at the possibility of CCC marking 2 disabled parking bays outside the premises prior to relocation of the Post Office.
- Councillors suggested it may be productive to have a meeting with the Traffic Manager to address parking issues.
- Longtown Primary School would become an Academy by September under the William Howard Trust. This would not change name, uniform and day to day would carry on as normal.
- Cllr MGu asked for clarification, that Bus users be notified of the A7 road closures schedule.

Cllr R Bloxham reported

- Gave an update from the Planning Committee meeting when Planning Application 16/0363 was considered. Subject to Northern Radio, who look after TV signals, mobile masts, report. Following their objection if their report, still to be received,

identified no problems, permission granted.

- Voiced concern that CCC Highways Transport Plan for this planning application was still awaited,
- Proposed a Public meeting with REG Windpower would be beneficial for residents.
