## Remembrance Sunday

## Highway issues

The following Highway issues are currently being addressed.

- Speeding on the A7 and A6071. There is still a problem with drivers ignoring the speed restrictions in place driving into Longtown.
- Westlinton Bridge and flooding is a high priority.
- Flooding on road in Swan Street and outside Spar Netherby Road
- Entrance to Burnside from Swan Street will have Keep Clear marking painted
- Arthuret Road to church footpath widening will be looked at.

## 2018 Boundary Review

The Boundary Commission for England published its revised proposals for new constituency boundaries on 17<sup>th</sup> October.

Publication of the revised proposals mark the start of an 8 week consultation which they are inviting people to view and comment on the new boundaries.

The Boundary Commission for England must make its recommendations for new Parliamentary boundaries to Parliament in September 2018. This is the last round of public consultation.
